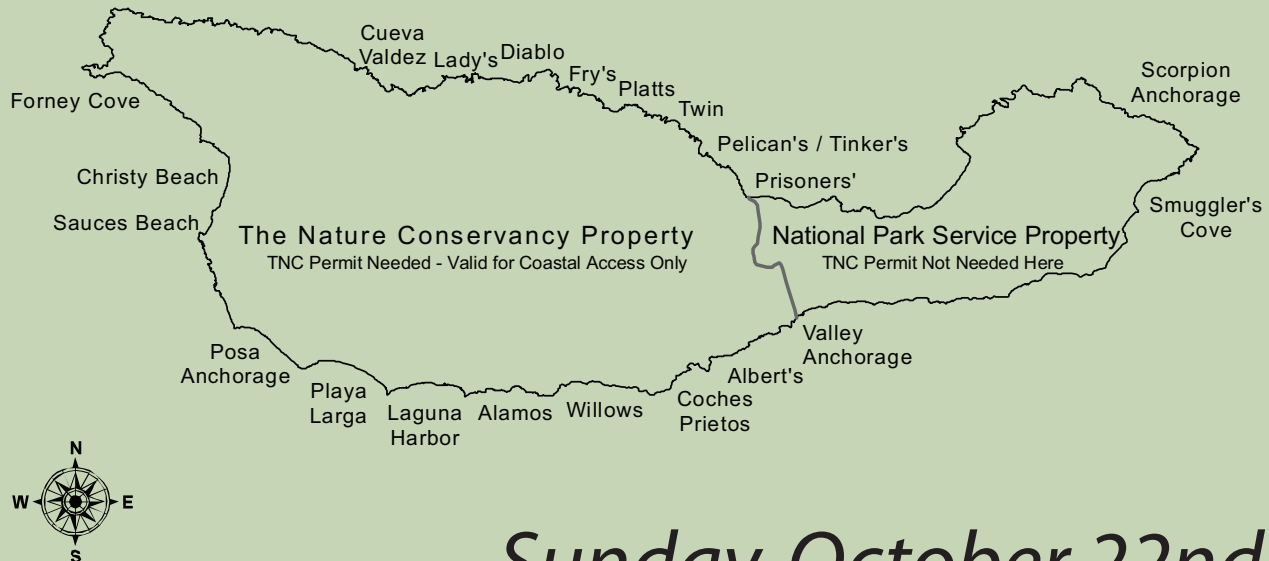

CHANNEL ISLANDS BEACH CLEANUP

Scheduled for Sunday October 22, the first annual Channel Islands Beach Cleanup will target cleanup effort at Santa Cruz island. The pilot program was initiated by local boating enthusiast Dr. Jack Dawson, based on his concern about the amount of trash washing ashore on the islands. Various agencies and organizations support the effort, including The Nature Conservancy, Channel Islands National Marine Sanctuary, California Department of Fish & Game, and local businesses Paddle Sports and Marborg Industries.
